Discover

Discover social business opportunities as opportunities for social wealth creation. Market investigation, idea generation and verification.

Develop

Learn techniques to analyse and prioritize product functions and to name the quality of the product by correlating functions against market requirements and technical specifications. Team process requires focus on team cultivation and knowledge development through self-studies and tutor guiding.

Realize

In this part of the course the student is given an overview of various Social Business Models that could suite the very idea that the students have come up with in previous parts of the course. Students are trained to express their ideas and solution orally as well as in writing. The written statement should take form of a business plan.
